Programme structure

The two-year program will include two semesters of study at or two collaborating universities besides the home university.

Decisions about the structure of the program are being made jointly by the members of the consortium (Wien, Maynooth, Barcelona, Ljubljana and Stockholm).

Goals

After having satisfactorily completed the program the student should:

- * Have a profound knowledge of social anthropological theory of science, methods and theory
- * Have insight into a number of theoretical and/or regional areas of specialization with focus on transnational processes, cultural differences, and new forms of identity
- * Have written a longer thesis based on a solid field investigation
- * Be well-acquainted with and capable of academic writing
- * Be able to work professionally as a social anthropologist

Courses

CREOLE represents a specialised MA-degree project by a consortium of fem institutions from six countries, and six different languages in the subject areas of Anthropology/International Relations/Humanities. It focuses on three major topics - transnational processes, cultural differences, and new forms of identity. These will be dealt with in three main fields, movement of people and dynamics of identity formation, material culture and consumption, and visual culture/popular culture.

More specific decisions on content will be taken jointly with the member partners in the consortium (Wien, Maynooth, Barcelona, Ljubljana and Stockholm). The following courses will be included in the program in Stockholm:

- * Professional Roles for Anthropologists, 7,5 credits
- * Transnational Migration, 7,5 credits
- * The Anthropology of the Global Economy, 7,5 credits
- * Digital Anthropology, 7,5 credits
- * Anthropological Method, 7,5 credits
- * Frontlines in Anthropological Theory, 7,5 credits
- * Theory of Anthropological Science, 7,5 credits
